The Welcome Baby Program is available to all Windham** County residents with infants or children up to age 4. Of course this includes adopted or fostered infants/young children.

The Welcome Baby Program provides families with a Welcome Baby bag. The bag is full of gifts/coupons and resource information that is helpful to parents. The traditional Welcome Baby visit from a community member is **NOT** happening during this time, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, a bag can be dropped off at your home, or arrangements can be made for you to pick one up. (Precautions are taken in preparing and delivering the bags to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission).
